PROFICIENCY IN DESIGNATED SECURITY DUTIES COURSE

INTRODUCTION

As you are aware, the NEW SECURITY training requirements for seafarers (STCW Reg. VI-6) will take effect from 1 January 2014 and all Shipping Companies are reminded to focus on this tight timeline.

COURSE AIM

Proficiency in Designated Security Duties course is for ALL seafarers who are given security duties on-board ships. Most Company Ship Security Plans have appointed officers, engineers, deck and engine ratings to handle security duties. Our course meets the requirements of Section A-VI paragraphs 6-8 of the amended STCW code and leads to the issue of an STCW Certificate of Proficiency. Person attending the Proficiency in Designated Security Duties will automatically obtain the STCW Certificate of Proficiency Awareness.

COURSE OBJECTIVE

- Maintain the conditions set out in a ship security plan and contribute to the enhancement of maritime security through heightened awareness.
- Recognise security risk and threats.
- Understand the need for, and methods of, maintaining security awareness and vigilance.
- Undertake regular security inspections.
- Properly use security equipment and systems.

ASSESSMENT AND CERTIFICATION

There is a course assessment at the end of the course. Participants must pass the assessment to successfully complete the course. Upon passing, a certificate will be issued.
